Use on the inlet side of a Graco Pressure Washer to filter out impurities from the water supply. Filtering increases pump life and helps provide trouble–free operation.

INSTALLATION


<u>To install the filter</u>, remove the garden hose adapter (A) and adapter nut (D) from the inlet (B) of the pump. Screw the filter's 1/2 npt(m) outlet (C) into the pump inlet. Insert the garden hose adapter through the adapter nut and screw it into the filter's 1/2 npt(f) inlet (E). Place the inlet screen (F) into the adapter nut and then screw a standard 3/4 in. garden hose threaded coupling (G) into the nut. Turn on the water and check for leaks. Use pipe thread sealant or PTFE [®] tape on all threaded connections.

- WARNING -

To reduce the risk of component rupture and serious bodily injury, BE SURE the incoming fluid pressure does not exceed the *100 psi (7 bar) MAXIMUM WORKING PRESSURE* of this filter or of any other accessory or component in your system.

<u>If hard plumbing is used</u>, the filter may be installed as a part of the hard plumbing of the water supply. Connect a short piece of hose between the pump and the hard plumbing to permit normal equipment vibration.

SERVICE

Clean the filter at least once a week. Depending on use and water conditions, the filter may need to be cleaned more often. If the filter is plugged, the pressure washer's flowrate will decrease and the pump's noise level will increase.

To clean the filter, turn off the water and unscrew the filter cap (1) with a 10 mm hex key wrench. Check the o-ring (2) for damage and replace if necessary. Remove the filter screen (3) and thoroughly clean it. Replace the filter if it is damaged. Reinstall the screen in the filter body (4). Screw in the cap and tighten it firmly with the wrench. Refer to the Parts Drawing.
