

Replacing the EM5™ Meter Battery

Follow these steps when the battery icon on the LCD screen blinks continuously or the LCD screen does not activate or displays nonsense characters, indicating a low or dead battery.

It is important that you read and understand all instructions and hazards before operating this equipment.

Before you start

Be sure that you have a small, flat-blade screwdriver and a new 9-volt alkaline battery before you start to replace the battery.

- 1.** Pull down enough hose so that the meter can be supported on the floor or other flat work surface.



- 2.** Remove the boot from the meter.



- 3.** Remove the battery cover.




- 4.** Using a small flat-blade screwdriver, carefully pry out the battery. **Do not pull on the wires.**



- 5.** Hold the battery terminal strip and unsnap the battery from the strip. **Do not pull on the wires.**





6. Snap a new 9-volt alkaline battery onto the terminal strip.



7. Replace the battery in the meter cover.



8. Replace the battery cover.



9. Replace the boot.



10. Test the meter
