





Disassembly



Required Tools

- 5/32 in. (4 mm) Allen wrench
- 7/64 in. Allen wrench
- Flat blade screw driver
- O-ring pick
- Compatible solvent in container
- Installation Tool Kit 24T206 (includes seal and piston installation tools, purchase separately)
- 1. Disable gun assembly. See InvisiPac system man ual for instructions.



Material inside the applicator can be near setpoint temperature. Wear protective clothing to avoid severe burns.

2. Remove module from manifold while module is still hot.

NOTICE


Do not allow adhesive to enter the air ports, to allow air to flow through valve. Adhesive in the air ports will obstruct the flow of air and damage the valve.

- 3. Soak module in compatible solvent.
- 4. Disassemble the module.

NOTE: Complete steps 4a-4c to only replace the mod ule filter (E).

- a. Remove the spring retainer (A) and spring (B**X**).
- b. Remove the nozzle seat (C¥) and o-ring (D¥).
 Discard the o-ring.
- c. Remove the module filter assembly (E**≭**). Dis card the filter assembly.

- d. Remove the piston assembly $(F \bigstar)$.
- e. Remove the air rod u-cup seal (G**X**).
- f. Remove the fluid rod u-cup seal (HX).
- g. Remove the module body o-rings $(J\bigstar)$.



* Discard if rebuilding the entire module.

Reassembly

NOTICE
To prevent damage to the seals always use the Seal
Installation Tool (S) and Piston Installation Tool (P).

Complete steps 2-3 and 9 to only reassemble the mod ule filter.

 Lubricate fluid rod u-cup seal (4) and air rod u-cup seal (4) with high temperature grease (8). Place seals on the Seal Installation Tool (S), with the spring facing the tool, and install seals in the module housing. Seals (4) will snap in place.




FIG. 2: U-Cup Seals

2. Install module filter assembly (5).






- 3. Install o-ring (7) on nozzle seat (9). Lubricate with high temperature grease (8).
- 4. Install nozzle seat on module. Torque screws to 15-20 in.-lbs (1.7-2.3 N•m).

NOTICE

Do not scratch the piston rod. Damage to the piston rod will shorten module life.

5. Slide piston assembly (2) backwards through the Installation Tool (P) to press the seal in the piston.





 Lubricate piston assembly seal (2) with high tem perature grease (8). Install piston assembly into module housing with the Piston Installation Tool (P).





- Install spring (1) and spring retainer (A) on top of piston. Torque screws to 10-15 in.-lbs (1.1 - 1.7 N•m).
- 8. Install module housing o-rings (3). Lubricate with high temperature grease (8).
- Apply anti-seize to two screw threads (S). Install module on manifold with two screws. Torque to 28-32 in.-lbs (3.2-3.6 N•m).

- \triangle Apply high temperature grease to all o-ring surfaces and to piston seal bore surfaces of module housing.
- Torque to 10-15 in.-lbs (1.1 1.7 N•m).
