

Pressure Relief Procedure




SKIN INJECTION HAZARD

High-pressure fluid from dispense device, hose leaks, or ruptured components will pierce skin. This may look like just a cut, but it is a serious injury that can result in amputation. **Get immediate surgical treatment.**

Follow **Pressure Relief Procedure** in this manual, when you stop dispensing and before cleaning, checking, or servicing equipment.


- 1. Disconnect the power cable.
- 2. Relieve pressure in the system by using two wrenches working in opposite directions on the outlet fitting and the hose fitting to only loosen the fitting.

NOTE: When loosening pump element fitting, do not loosen the pump element. Loosening the pump element will change the output volume (FIG. 1).



Installation

- 1. See Pressure Relief instructions for any pump currently in use.
- 2. Disconnect power.
- 3. Disconnect the hose fitting from the outlet fitting.
- Remove the vent valve outlet plug using a 1/4 in. hex bit. A socket ratchet wrench is recommend (FIG. 2).



5. Install the straight fitting into the vent valve and tighten until snug (FIG. 3).





6. Remove the pump element plug located on the other side of the pump using a 1 1/8 in. wrench (FIG. 4).




- 7. Install the pump element and tighten to 50 in-lb (FIG. 5).
- 10. Holding the pump element with 1 1/8 in. wrench, tighten the elbow fitting so that it is facing the back of the Electric Grease Jockey (FIG. 7 and FIG. 8).






Remove the plug on the pump element (FIG. 6). 8.






9. Apply non-PTFE liquid thread sealant to the NPT threads of the elbow fitting that will be installed into the pump element.

NOTE: Non-PTFE liquid thread sealant is recommended so PTFE does not break off and cause damage to the injectors.





11. With both fittings now pointing toward the back of the Electric Grease Jockey, align and install the flared tube to the fittings (Fig. 9).




- 12. Reconnect power.
- 13. Run the pump until the grease being pumped from the outlet is free of air bubbles.
- 14. Reconnect the hose fitting to the pump outlet fitting.
