

CALIFORNIA EVAPORATIVE EMISSION CONTROL WARRANTY STATEMENT



YOUR WARRANTY RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

Graco Inc. is pleased to explain the evaporative emission control system's warranty on your engine. Graco Inc. must warrant the evaporative emission control system on your engine for the period listed below provided there has been no abuse, neglect or improper maintenance of your equipment leading to the failure of the evaporative emission control system.

Your evaporative emission control system may include parts such as: carburetor, fuel tanks, fuel lines (for liquid fuel and fuel vapors), fuel caps, valves, canisters, filters, clamps, connectors, and other associated components.

MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY COVERAGE:

This evaporative emission control system is warranted for two years. If any evaporative emission-related part on your equipment is defective, the part will be repaired or replaced by Graco Inc.

OWNER'S WARRANTY RESPONSIBILITIES:

As the owner, you are responsible for performance of the required maintenance listed in your owner's manual. Graco Inc. recommends that you retain all receipts covering maintenance on your engine, but Graco Inc. cannot deny warranty coverage solely for the lack of receipts.

As the owner, you should be aware that Graco Inc. may deny your warranty coverage if your engine or a part has failed due to abuse, neglect, or improper maintenance or unapproved modifications. You are responsible for presenting your engine to Graco Inc.'s distribution center or service center as soon as the problem exists. The warranty repairs shall be completed in a reasonable amount of time, not to exceed 30 days. If you have a question regarding your warranty coverage, you should contact Graco Inc Technical Support at 1-844-241-9499.

GENERAL EMISSIONS WARRANTY COVERAGE:

Graco Inc. warrants to the ultimate purchaser and each subsequent purchaser that the engine is: Designed, built and equipped so as to conform with all applicable regulations; and free from defects in materials and workmanship that cause the failure of a warranted part to be identical in all material respects to that part as described in Graco Inc.'s application for certification. The warranty period begins on the date the engine is delivered to an ultimate purchaser or first placed into service. The warranty period is two years. Subject to certain conditions and exclusions as stated below, the warranty on emission-related parts is as follows:

- (1) Any warranted part that is not scheduled for replacement as required maintenance in the written instructions supplied, is warranted for the warranty period stated above. If the part fails during the period of warranty coverage, the part will be repaired or replaced by Graco Inc. according to subsection (4) below. Any such part repaired or replaced under warranty will be warranted for the remainder of the period.
- (2) Any warranted part that is scheduled only for regular inspection in the written instructions supplied is warranted for the warranty period stated above. Any such part repaired or replaced under warranty will be warranted for the remaining warranty period.
- (3) Any warranted part that is scheduled for replacement as required maintenance in the written instructions supplied is warranted for the period of time before the first scheduled replacement ate for that part. If the part fails before the first scheduled replacement, the part will be repaired or replaced by Graco Inc. according to subsection (4) below. Any such part repaired or replaced under warranty will be warranted for the remainder of the period prior to the first scheduled replacement point for the part.
- (4) Repair or replacement of any warranted part under the warranty provisions herein must be performed at a warranty station at no charge to the owner.
- (5) Notwithstanding the provisions herein, warranty services or repairs will be provided at all of our distribution centers that are franchised to service the subject engines or equipment.
- (6) The engine owner will not be charged for diagnostic labor that is directly associated with diagnosis of a defective, emission-related warranted part, provided that such diagnostic work is performed at a warranty station.
- (7) Graco Inc. is liable for damages to other engine or equipment components proximately caused by a failure under warranty of any warranted part.

(8) Throughout the engine warranty period stated above, Graco Inc. will maintain a supply of warranted parts sufficient to meet the expected demand for such parts.

(9) Any replacement part may be used in the performance of any warranty maintenance or repairs and must be provided without charge to the owner. Such use will not reduce the warranty obligations of Graco Inc.

(10) The use of any non-exempted add-on or modified parts by the ultimate purchaser will be grounds for disallowing a warranty claims. Graco Inc. will not be liable to warrant failures of warranted parts caused by the use of a non-exempted add-on or modified part.

WARRANTED PARTS:

The repair or replacement of any warranted part otherwise eligible for warranty coverage may be excluded from such warranty coverage if Graco Inc. demonstrates that the engine has been abused, neglected, or improperly maintained, and that such abuse, neglect, or improper maintenance was the direct cause of the need for repair or replacement of the part. The following emission warranty parts list are covered:

Fuel tank

Fuel cap

Carbon canister

Fuel lines (for liquid fuel and fuel vapors)

Clamps

Bracket
