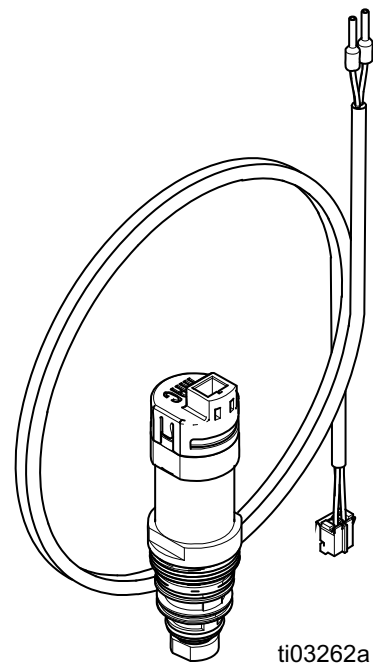

This equipment stays pressurized until pressure is manually relieved. 1. Perform the Pressure Relief procedure in the ProMix V Package Meter Proportioner Instructions manual. See **Related Manuals**, page 2.
2. Perform the Shutdown procedure in the ProMix V Package Meter Proportioner Instructions manual. See **Related Manuals**, page 2.
3. For easier access to the solenoid, remove the mix manifold from the enclosure assembly by removing the bolts on the bottom that go directly into the mix manifold. Be sure to label all tubes that go to the manifold before removing it from the enclosure.

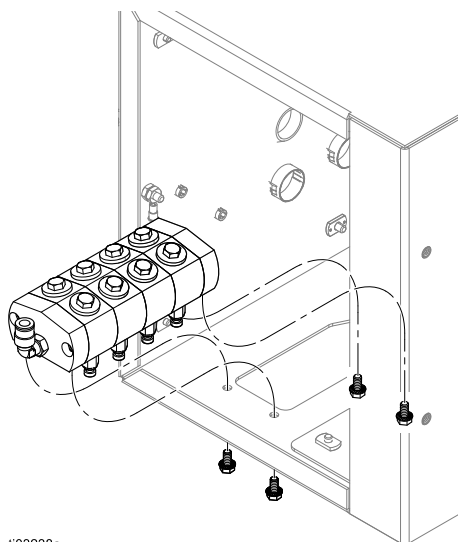

4. Remove the plug, examine the port, and remove any burrs or other debris.
5. Apply a small amount of grease (supplied by customer) to the o-rings on the solenoid.

NOTE: Do not apply too much grease to the o-rings. An excessive amount of grease may interfere with air flow.

6. Remove the wiring harness on the solenoid and install the supplied cable bundle (102) (gray cable bundle) onto the solenoid.
7. Install the solenoid valve (101), and tighten using the flats on the solenoid valve.

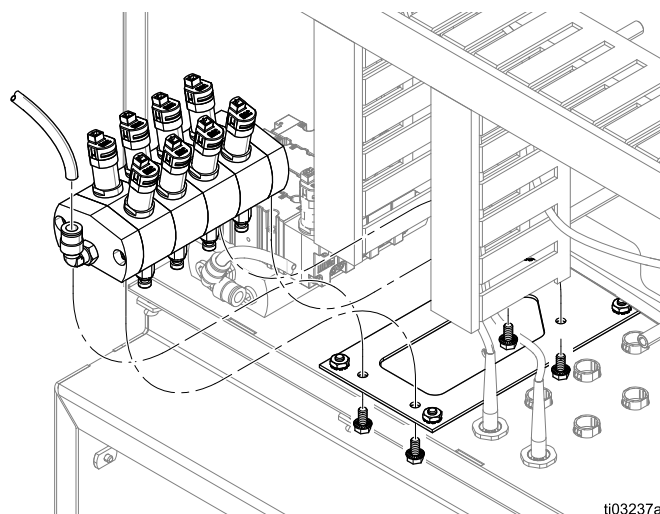

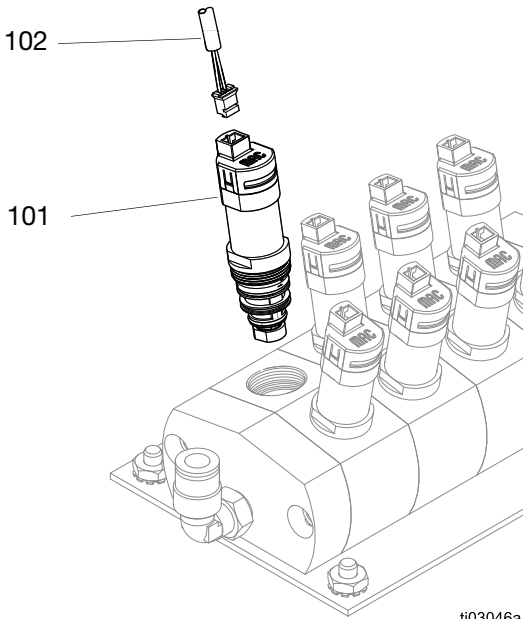
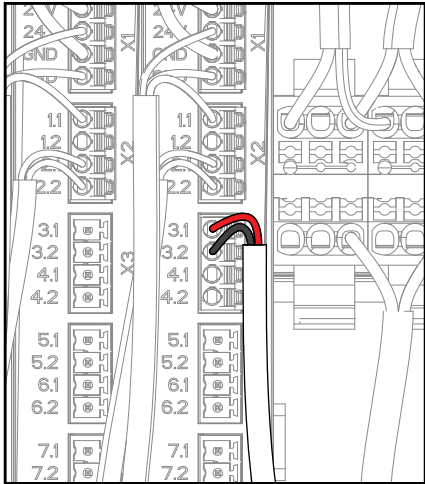
8. Reinstall the mix manifold.
9. Route new air hoses as necessary.
10. Remove the plastic wiring covers on the enclosure, and route wiring to the I/O modules.
11. Install the wires into the next available open ports of the I/O module. See FIG. 3.

NOTE: The solenoids do not have a negative or positive, so placement of specific wire colors is irrelevant. Make sure to install wires in the next pair of open ports on the terminal block.

12. See the ProMix V Package Meter Proportioner Instructions manual to allocate the I/O. See **Related Manuals**, page 2.
